



**TERMS AND CONDITIONS
OF THE TIP TAP WORKSHOP
26-28 MAY 2023**

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The organiser of the workshop is: ANNA KOŁAKOWSKA TIP TAP

2. Date of workshop: **26-28.05.2023**. (3 days)
3. The workshop will take place in Warsaw at 9 Indiry Gandhi Street - in the Tip Tap Tap Dance School and in one of the Dance halls of Ursynowskie Centrum Kultury "Alternatywy".
4. The following division of groups applies:
 - Beginners
 - Intermediate
 - Advanced
5. The instructor leading the workshop has the right to move a participant to another advanced group.
6. Recording is only possible with the permission of the Instructor.

REGISTRATION

1. Registration could be made from 1.04.2023 to 25.05.2023 or until places are sold out.
2. Registration shall be made by registration form and payment into a bank account or in cash by the deadline specified in the application confirmation e-mail.
3. Minors are required to provide a statement signed by a legal guardian before the workshop.
4. The number of places is limited. Priority will be given to persons who have sent the completed form and made the payment. The number of available places may change as a result of deleting persons who have not paid for the workshop.

COSTS

1. The fee depends on the registration deadline:
 - Registration within 01 - 30.04.2023 - **500 zł**
 - Registration within 01 - 14.05.2023 - **580 zł**
 - Registration within 15 - 25.05.2023 - **660 zł**

In the title of the transfer, please write "**Workshop - Name and Surname**"
3. Payment must be made by the deadline specified in the registration confirmation email. In case of non-payment, the participant will be struck off the list.
4. In the event of cancellation of the workshop by 14 May 2023, after booking a place and making a payment, the organiser will refund the fee minus the necessary costs resulting from the organisation of the workshop. Written cancellations, stating the account number to which the refund is to be made, shall be accepted until 14 May 2023 at 23:59 at the latest. Refunds for cancellations shall be made within 14 days from the date of

the written cancellation. Written cancellations will be accepted when sent to **anula@tiptap.pl**, no other form of cancellation will be accepted.

5. In case of cancellation of the workshop after 14 May 2023, the organiser will not refund the payment made.
6. Other cases will be considered individually.
7. The organiser reserves the right to cancel the workshop in the event of fortuitous events, including force majeure. In such a case, 100% of the payment made will be refunded
